Praxis Scores, by Fall-Start AY

100% (N = 39) of candidates who have completed the program in the last two years have taken the Praxis exam and achieved a score above the passing score of 147 required for national certification (NCSP). The 2020-21 interns' mean score was 174.45 (SD 7.37) and the range of total scores was 163-195. The 2021-22 interns' mean score was 167.16 (SD 9.99) and the range of total scores was 152-191. The ETS (2021) Understanding Your Praxis Scores 2021-2022 publication reported a median score of 168 and an average performance range of 161-175. On a whole, LC School Psychology program candidates' performance on the exam are aligned with the national average and expected performance on the exam.
