GSEC School-Based Programs: Exam Triennium Passrates, by Program

Data Findings, ESOL: Data from three cycles were aggregated together into triennia, due to low n in some exam years (In the 2022-2023 exam year n = 14; in 2023-2024 n = 7; in 2024-2025 n = 2). Candidates' mean scores were relatively consistent over time, and well above the state mean. All candidates ultimately passed the exam.

Data Findings, Reading: Data from four cycles has been aggregated together into biennia due to low n in all years (In the 2021-2022 exam year n = 8; 2022-2023 n = 4; 2023-2024 n=8; 2024-2025 n = 8). Candidates' mean scores were slightly above the biennium state means.

Data Findings, Special Education: Data from four cycles of the old NES special education exam (test ID 601) were aggregated together into biennia, due to low n's in some exam years (In the 2021-2022 exam year n = 7; 2022-2023 n = 13; 2023-2024 n = 8; 2024-2025 n = 7). Candidates' mean scores were relatively consistent over time, and above the state mean in both biennia. All candidates passed the exam on the first attempt. So far we have received only one score on the new NES special education exam (test ID 602) – results of this exam will be redacted until we reach n of 10.
